Project title:	Review and application of questionnaires and assessments for prediabetes and diabetes screening and diagnosis
Project duration, hours of engagement & delivery mode	10 weeks, 28 hours per week, on-site at the School of Pharmacy with some work from home if covid restrictions require.
Description:	You will work with a UQ PhD student to review the questionnaires that are in use around the world to screen for prediabetes and diabetes, and apply selected tools to data from participants in a clinical trial.
Expected outcomes and deliverables:	The student will gain experience of reviewing the literature and analysing clinical trial data.
Suitable for:	This project is open to students who have an interest in complementary medicines, good communication skills, attention to detail, numeracy skills and are familiar with Excel. Experience using library databases to review the literature is helpful. Completion of a Certificate in Good Clinical Practice will be required, but this may be undertaken at the start of the project if not prior.
