

A recognised qualification

The UQ Bachelor of Pharmacy (Honours) is formally recognised by the Singapore Pharmacy Council. Our graduates practice around the world, in Australia, Canada and Singapore. Australian registration necessitates meeting standards set by the Pharmacy Board of Australia (PBA), including completing an Intern Training Program, 1,824 hours of clinical practice and examinations approved by the PBA, after graduation.



Scholarship

The School of Pharmacy offers a \$3,000 scholarship to be awarded annually to the highest achieving student from a Polytechnic in Singapore, who through previous study enrols directly into the second year of the Bachelor of Pharmacy (Honours) program. Allocation is based on academic achievement. All eligible applicants are considered automatically (no application form required).

Developed by the UQ School of Pharmacy, the Skills for Communicating and Relating in Pharmacy Training (SCRIPT) program helps students master cross-cultural communication with patients and health professionals, increasing employment prospects.

You can also engage in placements anywhere medicines are found eg. in community health clinics, ambulances services and other areas.

The Clinical and Experimental Therapeutics major is for high achieving students who want an in-depth research experience. Students undertake a research project under the guidance of an experienced researcher with no extra time or cost. Past UQ Bachelor of Pharmacy (Honours) graduates now have successful careers in pharmaceutical companies, research institutes, hospitals, government agencies and universities — in Australia, UK, USA and Singapore.

We teach you how to collaborate with other health professionals. Starting in year one with HLTH1000 Professions, People and Healthcare, you join 14 health disciplines to learn about health and wellbeing from a range of perspectives and how to navigate the complexity of health and social care systems locally and globally.
