Project title:	Designing and preparing a clinical trial protocol

Description:	You will help to prepare the protocol and supporting documentation for a clinical trial to test the pharmacokinetics of a medication. This will involve reviewing the relevant literature, similar studies and similar protocols in order to prepare the documentation. You will meet with the supervisor regularly, on site or via teleconference, for discussions and planning. This is an independent project that isn't directly associated with current research but involvement with the wider research team who work on related topics will be encouraged.
Expected learning outcomes and deliverables:	You will gain experience in medical writing, good clinical practice, and ethical review requirements.
Suitable for:	This project is suitable for students who have an appreciation of Good Clinical Practice, an interest in medical writing, and good written communication skills. Students who have completed a course in a related area, such as clinical trial design or research methods, and who are interested in a career in the clinical trials industry will be given priority. Previous experience as a participant of a clinical trial would be beneficial but is not necessary.
